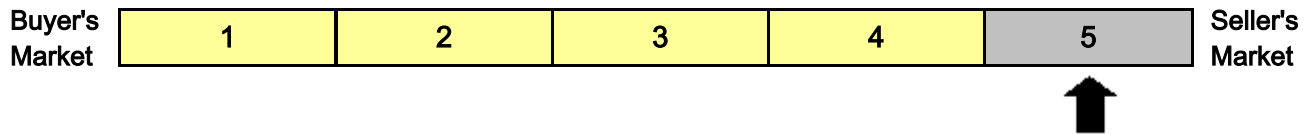


## Fairfax City, VA



### Labor Market :

Employment increased by 171 jobs in Fairfax City during April and May. However, the number of job seekers also increased. The combined effect of these two trends was an increase in the average monthly unemployment rate from 2.4% for the first quarter to 2.6% in the first two months of the second quarter. The solid job growth may provide strong home sales, while historically low mortgage rates should continue to spur sales.
